Job Purpose:

The Preschool Assistant Teacher supports the well-being of the children in the preschool program and teaches the extended care program.

Principal Responsibilities:

- Teaching of extended care preschool program- maintaining a healthy, safe, and positive environment for children utilizing nature as the organizing principal for all learning
- Support Preschool Team during the ½ day preschool program
- Assist Preschool Team with the development and implementation of daily practices and routines, as well as seasonal, place-based, emergent curriculum that promotes early childhood development and deep nature connection
- Communicate with parents about their child's development and daily experiences; including involvement with parent/teacher conferences at least twice per school year
- Participate in family events and parent education programs
- Ensure the indoor and outdoor learning environments are in good condition to support safe, engaging, rich in experience, and positive child development
- Serve as a Preschool teacher for Summer Camp
